**IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF FREEDOM CABS, INC FOR INCREASE IN RATES FOR SPECIFIED TRANSPORTATION**

**NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE**

Freedom Cabs, Inc. filed changes in Passenger Tariff, Colorado PUC No. 6 on May 11, 2017 that result in increases in fares for the transportation of passengers in scheduled service between points in the Denver metro area and the Denver International Airport, Colorado area.

Freedom Cabs, Inc. proposes to increase the scheduled fares as follows:

	Existing	Proposed
Flag drop –	\$2.00	\$2.20
The charge for each additional 1/11 <sup>th</sup> of a mile is \$.20	1/10 <sup>th</sup>	1/11 <sup>th</sup> of a mile
The charge per mile after the first mile	\$0.00	\$2.20
The charge for each 36 seconds of waiting time is \$.20	40	36 seconds
The charge for each 36 seconds of traffic delay is \$.20	40	36 seconds

The increased fares are proposed to become effective June 12, 2017, unless the Colorado Public Utilities Commission suspends the effective date of the proposed changes.

Objections to the proposed tariff changes must be made in writing and filed with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, CO 80202, at least 10 days before the effective date of June 12, 2017. If the Commission sets the matter for hearing, the filing of a written objection will not by itself allow a person to participate in the hearing. To participate in the hearing, a party must also file a written intervention and receive leave of the Commission to intervene. Requests to intervene as a party must comply with Commission rules.
